AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF GLENDALE, MISSOURI FOR SALT STORAGE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WARSON WOODS TO EXECUTE SAME.

WHEREAS, Sections 70.210 to 70.320 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, authorize municipalities to contract and cooperate with each other for the planning, development, construction, acquisition or operation of any public improvement or facility or for a common service; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Glendale owns and operates a Public Works facility located at 721 Bismark Avenue in the City of Glendale (the "Glendale Public Works Facility") where, among other things, it houses its equipment for snow and ice removal and stores de-icing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warson Woods is responsible for ensuring that the City's streets are plowed and/or de-iced during snow and ice events; and

WHEREAS, at its Public Works Facility, the City of Glendale has constructed a structure to store its de-icing salt ("Salt") and has available heavy equipment for loading and maintaining the Salt; and

WHEREAS, the market for securing Salt has changed as demand for Salt has increased requiring cities to pre-buy needed Salt as opposed to obtaining it on an "as-needed" basis necessitating greater storage areas for Salt; and

WHEREAS, the City of Warson Woods is desirous of securing space at the Glendale Public Works Facility for the storage of Salt for use in the City of Warson Woods which requires the construction of a new storage structure at the Glendale Public Works Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen is desirous of entering into an agreement with the City of Glendale to facilitate the storage of Salt; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARSON WOODS, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Aldermen does hereby approve, and the Mayor of the City of Warson Woods is authorized to enter into, an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement (the "Agreement") with the City of Glendale for the storage of salt which Agreement shall be substantially in form of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval.
