INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN GOSH

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AMENDING SECTION 215.840, "WEAPONS – CARRY CONCEALED – OTHER UNLAWFUL USE," OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF WARSON WOODS, MISSOURI TO COMPLY WITH CHANGES IN STATE LAW.

WHEREAS, the Missouri Legislature enacted Senate Bill 656 which allows persons with a valid concealed carry endorsement or permit to open carry a firearm; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen now desires to amend its code of ordinances to conform to changes in Missouri law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARSON WOODS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 215.840, entitled "*Weapons – Carrying Concealed – Other Unlawful Use,*" is hereby amended by repealing Subsection D in its entirety and enacting a new Subsection D to read as follows:

D. Subparagraphs (1), (6), and (7) of Subsection (A) of this Section shall not apply to any person who has a valid concealed carry endorsement or permit issued pursuant to Section 571.101 to 571.121 or a valid permit or endorsement to carry concealed firearms issued by another state or political subdivision of another state. **However, any person with a valid concealed carry endorsement or permit who is open carrying a firearm: (1) shall have in his or her possession at all times a valid concealed carry endorsement or permit from this state, or a permit from another state that is recognized by this state; and (2) shall display his or her concealed carry endorsement or permit upon demand of a law enforcement officer.**

SECTION 2. Warson Woods Municipal Code Section 215.910 "*Open Display of Firearm Permitted, When*" is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.
