AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 230 OF THE WARSON WOODS MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO PARK REGULATIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARSON WOODS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Aldermen hereby amends Section 230.020 (“Uses and Prohibitions”) of Chapter 230 of the Code of the City of Warson Woods by adding a new Subsection R, to read as follows:

Section 230.020 Uses and Prohibitions.

* * *

R. Reserved Areas. Upon being notified of such reservation, persons using the Park shall vacate any areas that have been reserved at the time of the reservation. It shall be unlawful for any person while in a Park to enter into with the intent to disturb, or, after being asked to leave by the Reservation Holder or by the Police, to loiter or remain within any area reserved for use by another person or group under a valid reservation issued by the City pursuant to this Section 230.040 (the “Reservation Holder”). Violation of this Section 230.020.R shall be punishable under Section 100.220 and shall also be a per se Peace Disturbance in violation of Section 215.670.

SECTION 2. The Board of Aldermen hereby amends Section 230.030 (“Warson Woods Park Area Reservation Policy and Procedures”) of Chapter 230 of the Code of the City of Warson Woods by adding a new Subsection B.8, to read as follows:

Section 230.040 Warson Woods Park Area Reservation Policy and Procedures.

B. Reservations of Park Facilities.

* * *

8. At the expiration of the allotted time for a reservation, persons using the reserved area shall vacate the reserved area. The person reserving the Park area shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with this Section.

SECTION 3. The Board of Aldermen hereby amends Section 230.030 (“Warson Woods Park Area Reservation Policy and Procedures”) of Chapter 230 of the Code of the City of Warson Woods by adding a new Subsection B.8, to read as follows:

Section 230.040 Warson Woods Park Area Reservation Policy and Procedures.

* * *

F. Interference with Reservation. Persons using the Park shall vacate any areas that have been reserved upon being notified of such reservation. No person or persons not in possession of a valid reservation issued by the City may attempt to or in fact displace, oust, interfere with, or otherwise inhibit the use of the reserved area by another holding a valid reservation issued by the City.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval by the Board and the Mayor.
