

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH E.  
MEIER CONTRACTING, INC. FOR MULTI-YEAR STREET  
IMPROVEMENTS AND PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT.**

**Whereas**, the City of Warson Woods (“City”) sought bids from contractors for street improvements and pavement replacement services for 2017 and for a multi-year period; and

**Whereas**, the City’s Procurement Code, Chapter 130, provides procedures governing the procurement of materials, supplies, equipment and services for the City; and

**Whereas**, in compliance with the Procurement Code the City solicited and obtained formal competitive bids from four (4) bidders from the invitation for bids for the May 2017 Multi-Year Street Improvements and Pavement Replacement Contract (the “Contract”); and

**Whereas**, two bidders’ bids were deemed to be incomplete due to missing portions of the required documents, and therefore were not qualified to be awarded the bid; and

**Whereas**, E. Meier Contracting, Inc. has been determined to have submitted the lowest qualified bid and, thus, the lowest and best bid for contracting; and

**Whereas**, the Board of Aldermen (the “Board”) now desires to accept the bid of and approve an agreement with E. Meier Contracting, Inc. for the Multi-Year Street Improvements and Pavement Replacement Contract.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE  
CITY OF WARSON WOODS, MISSOURI AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Aldermen hereby approves, and the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Warson Woods, for the Multi-Year Street Improvements and Pavement Replacement Contract in the City of Warson Woods with E. Meier Contracting, Inc. The Contract shall be in substantially the form of City-Contractor Agreement marked “Exhibit 1” attached hereto and incorporated herein and made a part of this ordinance as if set forth in fully herein.

**SECTION 2.** The requirements of Section 292.675 RSMo., and the OSHA requirements and obligations in the Contract, are hereby incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

**SECTION 3.** The requirements of Section 290.210 RSMo., and the prevailing wage requirements and obligations in the Contract, including without limitation the specific prevailing wages (including the rate for holiday and overtime work) and the Missouri Department of Labor and Industrial Relations’ determination of the prevailing wages, are hereby incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Ordinance for all purposes.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage and approval by the Board and the Mayor.
