**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE I-A, “STOP SIGNS,” OF TITLE III, “TRAFFIC CODE,” OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF WARSON WOODS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF WARSON WOODS, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** Schedule I-A “Stop Signs” of Title III of the Municipal Code entitled “Traffic Code”, is hereby amended to add a requirement, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 335, that when stop signs are erected the drivers of motor vehicles shall stop at the three-way intersection of Renderer Drive and Garland Place, such amendment to read as follows:

**Schedule I-A. Stop Signs**

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 335, and when stop signs are erected the drivers of motor vehicles shall stop at the following locations:

**Location**

Renderer Drive at Garland Place—Three-way stop

**SECTION 2.** The City shall cause “Stop” signs to be installed as set forth in Section 1 above.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Aldermen and approval by the Mayor.
