**NOTICE OF PROPOSED SURVEYING WORK**

The Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD) will be studying proposed improvements to the sanitary sewer system in your area. MSD has contracted with Burns & McDonnell Engineering Company, Inc. to study and design the proposed improvements. The title of this project is *WW-2 and WW-3 Warson Woods Sanitary Relief*, and the MSD Project Number is 12302.

The project area is generally bounded by N Berry Road and Kortwright Avenue to the east, Dickson Street and Bennett Avenue to the west, Old Warson Road to the north, and Brownell Avenue to the south. Field surveys will be taking place in your neighborhood beginning within the next two (2) weeks and will last for about three (3) months. The field surveys will be performed by *Sabur, Inc.* The surveying will primarily occur along the route of the existing sewers and/or along neighborhood streets throughout the project area. They will be measuring the elevations of the houses along the alignment and may need to access properties to obtain accurate measurements.
